Foreign Economic Relations Board (DEİK), Türkiye's window to the world; is a voluntary-based business organization, aiming at strengthening the Turkish private sector since 1985.

With a key focus on "Business Diplomacy", DEİK has been working on developing foreign economic relations of Türkiye's private sector, seeking both foreign and domestic investment opportunities and enhancing bilateral trade between Türkiye and its potential partners.

With its 152 Business Councils worldwide, DEİK mainly acts to improve Türkiye's trade and investment relations in a strategic manner with direct contact in these 144 countries.

DEİK is working with the task of "conducting the foreign economic relations of the Turkish private sector" and carries out activities under the coordination of the Ministry of Trade.

BUSINESS COUNCILS

Business Councils that are responsible for applying the decisions taken at 'DEİK Board of Directors' or 'Business Council Executive Board' are the backbone mechanisms of DEİK.

Working towards establishing bilateral and multilateral corporate cooperation within the framework of the countries under their responsibility, sectors and purposes, Business Councils are structured in three different categories as: 'Country-Based Business Councils', 'Sectoral Business Councils' and 'Special-Purpose Business Councils'.





BUSINESS COUNCILS



The purpose of Country-Based Business Councils that are established based on cooperation agreements signed with counterpart organizations is to develop and deepen bilateral economic relations with the concerned countries. The purpose of Sectoral Business Councils is to gather valuable sector-related information in one place and, in collaboration with the public and private sector as well as with civil society organizations, to establish development plans.

World Turkish Business Council (DTIK) unites under a common roof Turkish business community and entrepreneurs located abroad. The purpose of the Outbound Investments Business Council is to understand the dynamics of Turkish private sector investments in foreign countries, to generate solutions for needs arising in connection with foreign investments, and to ensure a high degree of coordination with the public in this respect.

BANKING AND FINANCE WORKING GROUP

Chair: Alpaslan Çakar Board Member of DEİK and Cahir of Exective Board of Ziraat Bank

The Banking and Finance Working Group was established with the aim of increasing the financing of the Turkish private sector's foreign investments, foreign trade and cooperation with third countries in strategic markets. It aims to debelop policies and strategies regarding

- Providing long-term financing from abroad for these purposes,
- Developing joint innovative financing structures with foreign financing institutions,
- Increasing the effectiveness of Turkish banks in their overseas activities,
- Ensuring the expansion of correspondent banking relationships.

WORKING GROUPS



FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNING SERVICES WORKING GROUP

Chair: Prof. Dr. Mustafa Aydın Board Member of DEİK and Chair of Executive Board of Bil Holding

In addition to merchandise exports, the service sector has also started to take an important place in Türkiye's exports in recent years. The aim of the working group is to develop strategies and policies to;

- More effectively promote our foreign exchange earning services, which are increasing in the fields of education, health tourism, logistics and transportation, translation, mobile applications, informatics, film, marketing, promotion, technical consultancy and transit trade, in addition to tourism, which is a traditional service export,
 - Raise our country's position to higher levels in international service exports.

TWIN TRANSFORMATION WORKING GROUP

Chair: Dr. Erdem Erkul Board Member of DEİK and Executive Chair of Cerebrum Technology

The aim of the Twin Transformation Working Group, which was established to increase the efficiency of the Turkish economy by combining green and digital transformation processes, is;

- Developing strategies to support the Turkish private sector in complying with the European Green Deal and EU policies,
- Conducting studies on the international branding of digital technology companies and on their integration into the international ecosystem,
- Identifying needs in areas such as border carbon adjustments, green economy, green finance and sustainable energy, facilitating the adaptation of SMEs to digitalization processes and increasing the international brand value of digital technology companies.



LEGISLATION WORKING GROUP

Chair: İbrahim Burkay Board Member of DEİK and Chair of Bursa Chamber of Trade and Industry (BTSO)

It was established to identify problems related to legislation and taxation in order to improve the business environment in Türkiye, to increase the ease of doing business, to increase domestic and foreign investments, to develop solution suggestions and to contribute to the policy making process in other platforms, especially in the Tax Council. It aims to conduct studies on;

- International Tax Treaties based on the needs of the working group, international tax planning, global tax efficiency management, tax processes of mergers and acquisitions, changes in international legislation, tax processes of investment transactions, global tax deductions,
- Base erosion and profit shifting (BEPS 2.0) processes, Tax Compliance Act (FATCA), Common Reporting Standards (CRS) and Automatic Exchange of Information (AEOI) processes.



COUNTERPART ORGANIZATIONS OF BUSINESS COUNCILS

- Counterpart organizations are complementary elements of the Business Councils mechanism. Our Business Councils based in 144 countries have counterparts in the leading countries.
- Business Councils sign at least one memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the operating organizations affiliated with the chamber of commerce, chamber of industry or relevant ministries in the respective country in order to develop commercial relations, so that they can be established.
- Business Councils carry out their studies mutually with counterpart organizations to develop bilateral political, commercial, social and cultural relations.

MULTINATIONAL COOPERATION

DEİK works in cooperation with numerous international and regional organizations, as well as academic institutions. As the exclusive business partner of leading international organizations in Türkiye, DEİK develops joint projects and organizes events.

Within the framework of relations with international organizations, representation of the Turkish private sector and sharing opinions on the agenda, searching for economic opportunities and informing the business community.



■ DEİK represents Türkiye at the Black Sea Economic Cooperation Organization (BSEC) Business Council and organizes thematic Business Forums like KEİ Business Forums and "Development of Cooperation among SMEs in the Black Sea Region".

■ In coordination with the Ministry of Treasury and Finance of the Republic of Türkiye, DEİK introduces to the Turkish private sector the structures and activities of the Asian Development

Bank and the African Development Bank, and informs the companies about projects financed by Banks.

■ In coordination with the Ministry of Trade of the Republic of Türkiye, Türkiye-ECOWAS Economic and Business Forum is organized by DEİK under cooperation agreement with the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) and projects of the ECOWAS Bank for Investment and Development (BIDC- EBID) are promoted to Turkish companies.



COORDINATION WITH PUBLIC AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS

DEİK carries out all its activities in coordination with the Ministry of Trade of the Republic of Türkiye. The Board is also in close cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Türkiye and our other Ministries.



■ A coordination has been established for evaluating the means of investment and cooperation in the countries that fall within the areas of operation of TİKA (Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency) between TİKA Coordination Offices and DEİK Business Councils.

Common activities are carried out between DEİK and the Small and Medium Enterprises Development Organization (KOSGEB) for helping SMEs expand into foreign markets, turn towards export, develop common investments abroad and transfer technology.

■ DEİK provides representation on platforms such as YOİKK (Coordination Council for the Improvement of Investment Environment), the Trade Facilitation Coordination Committee, the Halal Accreditation Agency, the Tax Council, and the Istanbul Development Agency.



RELATIONS WITH PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS AND ORGANIZATIONS

We are in dialogue with non-governmental organizations as part of the activities and diaspora studies of Business Councils.



TURKISH SCHOLARSHIPS - TURKISH BUSINESS COMMUNITY

■ While designating students and departments that will be granted scholarships within the framework of "Turkish Scholarships" project carried out by the YTB, taking into account the privileged countries and sectors needed by the Turkish business community offers a long-term solution. With a protocol signed between DEİK and the YTB, "Turkish Scholarships" will be determined in line with the demands of the Turkish business community and internship will be provided to those students at our businesses.

EDUCATION COOPERATION

■ A protocol has been signed between the Turkish Maarif Foundation and DEİK, to develop cooperation projects related to education in the fields of social and cultural activities, foreign trade and others.

■ Projects are developed between DEİK and Istanbul Technical University (İTÜ) within the context of university-industry cooperation on employment, vocational education, institutionalization, business diplomacy, branding, human resources management processes, digitalization, human management summits, international organizations and research.

REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE IN BRUSSELS

DEİK's Representative Office in Brussels was established in 2018.

Our Representative Office in Brussels;

- Acts as a contact point between DEİK and Brussels-based EU agencies, think-tanks and the EU business community.
- Was established in support of Türkiye's EU process and works in close contact with the Permanent Representative of Türkiye to the EU, Department of the EU and DEİK's EU Working Group.
- Provides information and analysis about decisions and issues that concern the General-Secretariat of DEİK and DEİK members. Promotes studies regarding the Green Deal, the EU Funds and Customs Union Update.
- Views and opinions on issues that concern Türkiye and Turkish business community (Customs Union, Visa liberalization, Green Deal, etc.) are expressed to the EU Agencies and studies are carried out for the acceptance of these opinions.
- Further carries out studies on positive examples and projects that are based in Europe and will contribute to the Turkish economy.



REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE IN ANKARA

DEİK's Representative Office in Ankara was established in 2021.

A representative office was established in Ankara with a view to coordinate DEİK's relations at public agencies more rapidly and have closer contacts for diplomatic missions.

Maintaining the business diplomacy activities undertaken by Türkiye in order to strengthen the country's foreign economic relations through 152 Business Councils spread all around the world, DEİK's communication network in the capital city will grow stronger with the new representative office that has started operating in Ankara. DEİK's Representative Office in Ankara that started operating with the objective of working more rapidly and in full coordination with all public agencies and organizations, diplomatic missions, business community organizations and other non-governmental organizations, in particular public authorities, will assume institutional representation of Foreign Economic Relations Board (DEİK) in both national and international organizations held in Ankara.
